Manual Therapy Procedures

Question: What is the full scope of manual therapies?

Purpose: To identify, describe and understand manual assessment and treatment techniques used by practitioners from various professions.

Outcome: We will create a model of the general categories of manual assessment and treatment procedures to improve communication and understanding across professions.

Physiological Theories

Question: What are the physiological theories behind manual therapies?

Purpose: To review the theories within the manual therapy research literature.

Outcome: We will develop a compendium of the physiological theories as a resource in designing and reporting future research.

Measuring Physiological Effects

Question: What are the known physiological effects of manual procedures on body tissues?

Purpose: To review the tools used or could be used by researchers to measure the physiological effects of manual therapies.

Outcome: We will develop a compendium of tools available to researchers to assess manual therapy

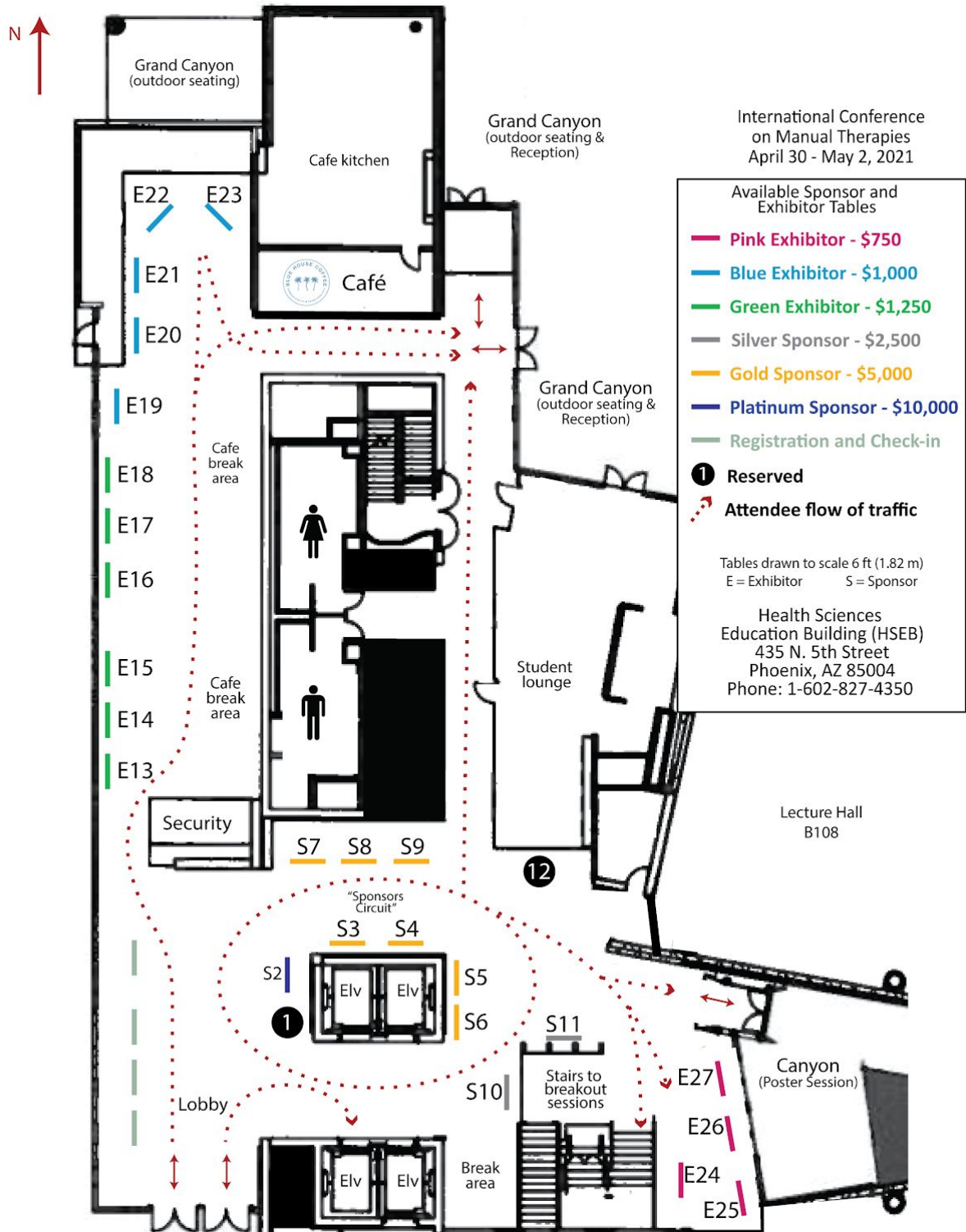
